This statement explains what information we collect, why we collect it and how we keep it secure. It also describes your rights and our legal obligation.

If we use your personal data for any new purposes, updates will be made to the policy information and changes communicated, where necessary in accordance with current data protection legislation.

[How we will use your personal data](#)

We are collecting your personal data for contract tracing purposes in line with the measures we are implementing in response to the risks identified by COVID-19. This is in order to protect you, our clients, visitors and the employees of Athlone Arts & Tourism

More specifically, the personal data collected about you will be used for the following purposes:

- To arrange your attendance at our buildings; and
- To maintain appropriate records of your interactions for contact tracing purposes.

[How will your personal data be collected](#)

Provided to us directly by you when you enter a building owned or controlled by us or when you pre-book admission tickets online.

[What information do we collect](#)

During the COVID-19 pandemic, it may be necessary for us to process the following information about you:

- Your name
- Contact Number

Please note that if you do not provide us with the personal data listed above, we may not be able to allow you to attend our buildings in person.

[What are our lawful bases for processing your Personal Data](#)

We process this personal data Under Article (6)(1)(e) of GDPR In the exercise of official authority vested in us as the controller and contained in the following legislation:

- Article 6(1)(e) – Performance of a public task that is carried out in the public interest
- Article 9(2)(i) – Processing is necessary for reasons of public interest in the area of public health,
- Section 53 of the Data Protection Act

Who will your personal data be shared with

We may share your personal data with regulatory bodies such as the HSE where we are obliged to make data available as required for the purposes of contact tracing.

The HSE may use your personal data as a "Controller". They have their own privacy notice, which can be found at <https://www.hse.ie/eng/privacy-statement/> and they have their own responsibilities to comply with applicable data protection laws.

How long will we hold your personal data

We will retain your personal data for 1 month from the date you last attended our buildings and we receive your personal data.

When we no longer need your personal data, we will securely delete or destroy your personal data.

How will we protect your personal data

Your data will be securely protected by rigorous measures and procedures to ensure it can't be seen, accessed by, or disclosed to anyone who shouldn't be allowed to view it.
